DUAL ENROLLMENT

Subjects:

- **9th Grade Health and Wellness--ASU** (3 credits per year, Eligibility: 9th grade students should discuss readiness with college counselor, Fall Semester)
- **9th Grade Computer Applications & Informational Technology--ASU** (3 credits per year, Eligibility: 9th grade students with 3.0+ GPA, Spring Semester)
- **9th Grade Biology--ASU** (4 credits per year, Eligibility: 9th grade students with 3.0+ GPA, Spring Semester)
- **10th Grade Algebra II/Precalculus--SEU** (3 credits per year, Eligibility: 10th grade students with 3.0+ GPA, Fall & Spring Semesters: August-May)
- **10th Grade Chemistry--ASU** (4 credits per year, Eligibility: 10th grade students with 3.0+ GPA, Spring Semester)

CLEP TESTS

Students must earn a passing score to receive college credit for the test, which varies by college. It is recommended students take only the test(s) they are most confident in and invest ample time studying. Not all colleges will accept CLEP exams. Before taking CLEP, research each college's CLEP policy and course equivalency guide.

Free study resource available through [ModernStates.org](https://www.modernstates.org). Upon successful completion, students receive a voucher for a free CLEP test.

DUAL ENROLLMENT

Dual enrollment can be earned in 9th through 12th grade. Great Hearts students must have a 3.0 unweighted cumulative or higher GPA to participate. Please note that grades earned through dual enrollment become part of the student's permanent college record/transcript. It is the responsibility of the student to research and determine how their dual enrollment credits may or may not transfer to their future 4-year college or university. After registration is complete and paid on Configio, NO REFUNDS will be issued. If you have questions about which option is best for you, please consult with your college counselor before purchasing.

AP EXAMS

Students do not need to be enrolled in an AP class to take the AP exam; however, Great Hearts courses do not precisely align with AP curriculum. It is recommended students invest time to prepare for the exam. In order to receive credit for an AP test, students typically need to score at least a 3, 4, or 5.
