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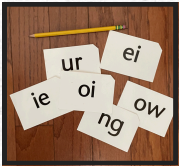

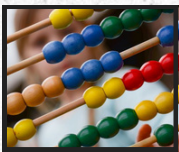

### ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS (ELA)

**\$765 A La Carte / \$573.50 Full Program**

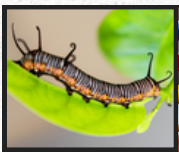

### MATHEMATICS

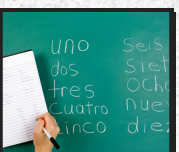

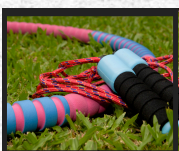
