ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS (ELA) \$765 A La Carte / \$573.50 Full Program

Students sharpen grammar skills through sentence diagramming, outlining, and structured writing exercises. They build expressive, well-structured writing and begin composing multi-paragraph expository and opinion essays. Literature includes The Secret Garden with discussions and independent reading. Students memorize and recite poetry and speeches, analyzing poetic form and language with greater depth.



MATHEMATICS

Students master all four operations with whole numbers, fractions, and decimals, and explore place value through 10 million. They dive deeper into geometry, including area, perimeter, volume, and surface area. Bar models support multi-step problem solving, and students are introduced to negative numbers and algebraic notation.



SCIENCE
