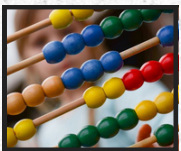

LITERATURE AND COMPOSITION

\$765 A La Carte / \$573.50 Full Program

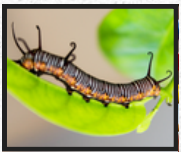
Students deepen reading and writing skills through classic novels, poetry, and stories. They write paragraphs and essays using narration, description, and evidence. Core texts include *Shane*, *Tom Sawyer*, *Anne of Green Gables*, and *The Wind in the Willows*, with grammar, composition, and literary analysis supporting clear, thoughtful writing.



MATHEMATICS

\$510 A La Carte / \$382.50 Full Program

This course bridges elementary math and Pre-Algebra, solidifying students' understanding of fractions, decimals, ratios, and percent. Students deepen their grasp of number operations, especially with negative numbers, and apply their knowledge to expressions, equations, and geometry. This course prepares students for success in Pre-Algebra and beyond.



LIFE SCIENCE

Students take a naturalist approach to the living world, focusing on observation, classification, and scientific communication. They explore the six kingdoms of life, with a deep dive into Kingdom Animalia. Nature journaling, sketching, and lab-based observation, help students connect form to function and develop habits of careful scientific inquiry.



HISTORY

Units highlight how different cultures have shaped the human story, with an emphasis on reflection, inquiry, and the richness of the Western tradition in a global context.



ART
