#### LITERATURE AND COMPOSITION

\$765 A La Carte / \$573.50 Full Program

Students deepen skills in reading, writing, and discussion through classic literature, grammar, and composition. They analyze themes, characters, and literary techniques while building structured writing skills, from paragraphs to five-paragraph essays. This course prepares students for upper-level seminars by strengthening critical thinking, clear communication, and thoughtful engagement with texts.



#### **MATHEMATICS**

# \$510 A La Carte / \$382.50 Full Program

Students build on their mastery of rational numbers to explore geometry, algebra, and probability. They study circles, ratios, proportionality, linear equations, and graphing while preparing for Algebra I. Emphasizing logic and proof, the course fosters mathematical reasoning and appreciation for the truth, beauty, and goodness found in mathematics.



### PHYSICAL SCIENCE

Students explore the order and laws of the physical world through observation, measurement, and modeling. They study matter, motion, forces, energy, and waves while learning to represent unseen phenomena with models and diagrams. #### HISTORY
